Hello everyone, I have prepared this kit to support you and your children in the next days of lockdown. So here are a bunch of activities to do at home! ENJOY them!



















"everything will be fine" = tutto andrà bene!









2. Let's CUT and PASTE to build a UNICORN!



















Cat Toilet Paper Roll Craft

This is a simple, three dimensional cat craft that young children enjoy making and playing with.

Materials:

- toilet paper roll or cardboard tube,
- a printer,
- something to color with,
- scissors,
- glue,
- paper.

Instructions:

- Print out the template
- Color the pieces as appropriate and cut them out.
- Glue the large rectangular piece around the toilet paper tube.
- Glue the tail onto the back of the toilet paper roll using the tabs to make a 3D effect.
- · Glue the head onto the front of the toilet paper roll.
- Glue on the paws (smaller ones are front paws). We usually make the crafts so they look like they are sitting on their haunche
